### ESB 5871 Septic Systems/Sewer Connection

Communities requiring hook up to sewers after septic system failure, must provide an appeals process for single family dwellings.

Local government allowed to impose fees for long range planning in addition to those for processing applications and SEPA.

- SSB 5864 -- Same as SHB 1576
- SHB 2156 Fees to abate nuisance, fund public records requests, Seattle sales/use tax.
- HB 2010 Same as ESB 5871 (Septic)
- SB 5721 -- Safe Routes funding

### ESB 5923 Impact Fee Deferral

Local governments must adopt a fee deferral system by September 1, 2016.

#### Fees deferred to:

- Final inspection
- -C/O
- Sale of property

Affects first 20 dwellings per year.
